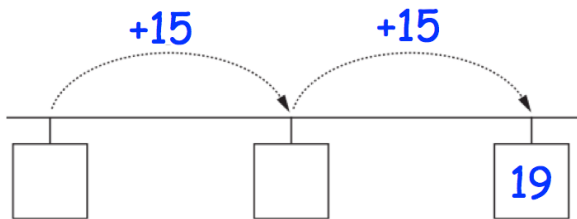

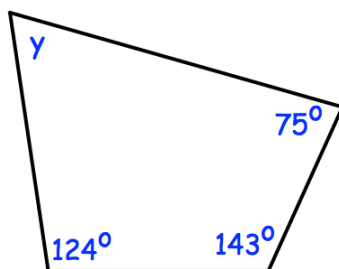
A sweet costs 7p.
