W varies directly to \sqrt{C} . If $W = 60$ when $C = 36$, find:

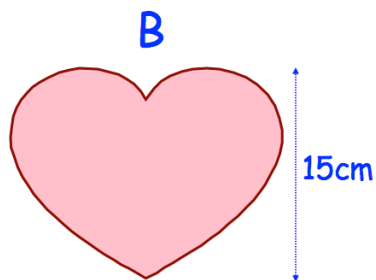
W when $C = 64$
