A box contains apples and oranges in the ratio 2:5.

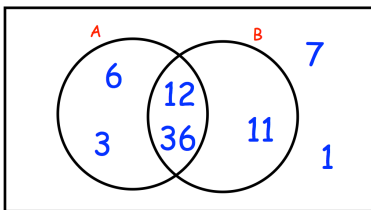
8 apples and 5 oranges are added to the box and the ratio of apples to oranges is now 4:7

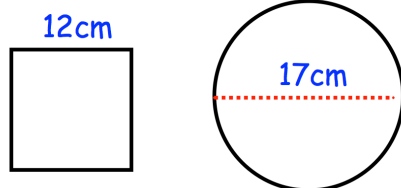
Write down the numbers that are in set
