Mary buys a lemon cupcake and a strawberry cupcake.

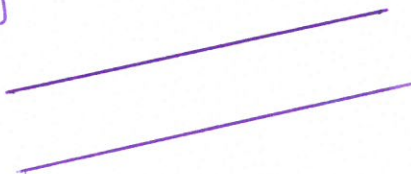
Each cupcake costs £1.35

£2.30 change

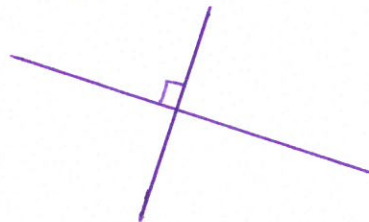
Draw two lines that are parallel
