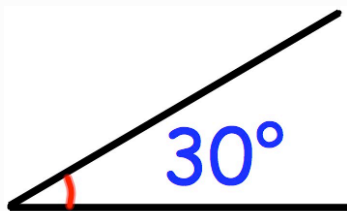

Add together

- The number of days in May 31
- The number of hours in a day 24
- The number of sides a decagon has. 10

$$\begin{array}{r} 31 \\ 24 \\ + 10 \\ \hline 65 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} 65 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Draw a 30 degree angle.



A chair costs £17

How much will 6 chairs cost?

$$\begin{array}{r} 17 \\ \times 6 \\ \hline 102 \end{array}$$

$$£ 102$$

2 birthday cards at £2.70 each
 1 toy at £6.50 each
 1 book at £5.75 each

Work out the total cost.

$$2 \times £2.70 = £5.40$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 5.40 \\ 6.50 \\ + 5.75 \\ \hline 17.65 \end{array}$$

$$£ 17.65$$

Oliver is paid £300 a week.
 Each week he saves two-fifths of his pay.

How much does he save each week?

$$\begin{array}{l} 300 \div 5 = 60 \\ 60 \times 2 = £120 \end{array}$$
