multiply the previous term by 3

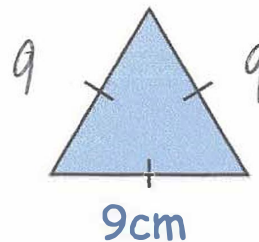
Isabella believes all prime numbers are odd.
