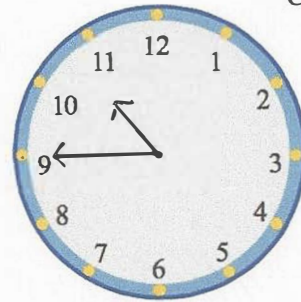

$$14 \times 5 = 70p$$

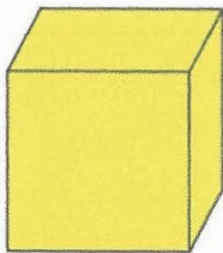
